ABOUT THE COURSE

The four-year diploma program encourages students to develop their creative style and artistic vision while gaining essential research, technical and communication skills. In one-to-one tutorials and through conceptual guidance with the internationally acclaimed fashion designers at the helm of the Department, students generate ideas, develop concepts and create and present individual, innovative and visionary womenswear, menswear or non-binary fashion collections. The main course, the so-called central artistic subject. focuses on developing an original and dynamic design vision. Accelerating creative, practical and intellectual development through interdisciplinary work processes and experimentation.

Graduates either found their own fashion labels or launch careers at existing national and international labels and/or fashion houses. Thanks to the continued high quality of the training it offers and its many successful graduates, the Fashion Department is one of the most important fashion education institutions worldwide.

ENTRANCE EXAM

To study at the Fashion Department, interested applicants need to pass an ENTRANCE EXAM. The next possible entrance exam will take place in January/February 2024.

The ENTRANCE EXAM will be held in 2 PHASES: PHASE 1 consists of online registration and uploading your application including a portfolio. All applicants who successfully complete PHASE 1 are qualified to participate in PHASE 2. PHASE 2 takes place in Vienna at the Fashion Department, participation in person during this period is required. A successfully passed entrance exam is valid for three semesters. The earliest date to start your studies is winter term 2024/25, starting October 2024.

Please read this document carefully to avoid an incomplete and therefore non-approved application. All mentioned times are Central European Time (CET).

CONTENT OF THE PORTFOLIO

1. COVER SHEET

including your first name, last name, phone number and a valid e-mail address

2. MOTIVATION STATEMENT IN ENGISH (1 page, max. 750 words) to include reasons for application, your interest in fashion and what you wish to further explore on the course

3. ILLUSTRATION (1 page) CREATE 1 SINGLE ILLUSTRATION/ 2D-ARTWORK OF YOUR CHOICE

- The medium used for the illustration is completely your choice (pencil, pen, painting, digital render, pastels, ink, charcoal, photo collage, collage, rubbing, imprint etc..).
- The subject matter and style of the illustration is completely of your choice.

4. PHOTO SERIES (max. 5 pages) SUBMIT 5 PHOTOGRAPHS OF YOUR CHOICE WHICH DEMONSTRATE YOUR CREATIVE VISION AND HOW YOU SEE THE WORLD

- These must be personal photographs (old or new, taken by yourself or somebody you know personally). Images must not be from source materials.
- There are no rules for the subject matter, style or format of the photographs: images can be of yourself, your environment, other people, objects, places, landscapes, abstract or mood, things that you have made or noticed etc.
- Each image should feature a single word or short text description, in the style of your choosing (max. 10 words each image).

5. FASHION COLLECTION (max. 13 pages) DESIGN A WOMENSWEAR, MENSWEAR OR NON-BINARY CAPSULE COLLECTION

- Visual and conceptual research
- Drawings (or collages) a minimum 5 full looks
- Documentation of 3D-development ideas, designs or details made from white fabric, photographed on a model or mannequin
- Documentation of 2D-development ideas, print or fabric developments

6. PREVIOUS WORK (max. 4 pages)

if you have previous work within any creative field and/or from any artistic training, include images.

FORMAT OF THE PORTFOLIO

- please create one document
- in A4 landscape format only
- scanned with a maximum of 150 dpi per page
- format exclusively PDF
- the size of the PDF document may not exceed 50 MB
- save this PDF document under your last name, first name, for example Green-Craig.pdf

We offer interested applicants the possibility of a portfolio consultation with a team member of the Fashion Department. Please note that only one consultation per interested applicant is possible, multiple participation is not permitted.

For this consulting please prepare your PORTFOLIO in edited version, format and content see page 3/7. The content of chapter 3. to 6. may be finished or in progress, depending what you have done so far. You do not need to include chapter 2.


